When the writers penned the Word of God under the divine inspiration of the Holy Spirit of God, a truly remarkable revelation	NOTES
was made concerning the use of the word ⁽¹⁾ , as	
both a source of $^{(2)}$ and $^{(3)}$.	
In hundreds of references, beginning in Genesis 4:26 and continuing through Revelation 22:4, concerning Himself, God reveals the ⁽⁴⁾ and ⁽⁵⁾ without specifically identifying a definite designation to a particular personage or attribute defined by name.	
Example: His mighty power, ⁽⁶⁾ ,

are names readily associated with His power of His strength and authority. They define a truth concerning God.	
When we began our study, we emphasized that God desires man to $^{(11)}$ God. That is to $^{(12)}$ God: $^{(13)}$ and $^{(14)}$	
God reveals Himself to man. Man learns new truth concerning God and His interaction with man. This truth is defined or identified by a personal name.

The Name

We have learned all that God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are in themselves is manifested in their names.

As is their names so they are, which brings us back to our original question, *"WHAT'S IN A NAME?"*

"The Name" refers to accomplishments or characteristics that are consistent with God and all that God is and does.

Jesus often spoke in reference to His Name; *"in my name or my name's sake."* (*Matthew* 10:22, 18:20, *John* 14:13, *Acts* 9:16)

The exact name referred to is not always mentioned. It could be (15) ______, or (16) _____, or (17) _____, several other descriptive titles given Him.

Acts 4:17,18 – The disciples were forbidden to speak in that name, *"Speak to no man in that name,"* which we find in the context to be *"...speak not at all nor teach in the name of Jesus."*

When our Lord Jesus Christ states in John 14:13, "*And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do* . . ., " what name does He refer to? ⁽¹⁸⁾_____! His name encompasses all that God is or does!

Many times God's people refer to calling upon ⁽¹⁹⁾"_____."

(Genesis 16:13, 21:33, Exodus 5:23, 9:16, 20:24, Leviticus 19:12)

Moses warned the children of Israel, "that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD;" (Deuteronomy 28:58) Here the name is identified, but in many cases it is not readily identified; it is defined, or described through additional references within the context.

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The Name

NOTES	 Example: " they that love his name shall dwell therein." (Psaln 69:36) The preceding verse states "God will save Zion" (Psaln 69:35), so the implication would be the name "Elohim". (Psaln 5:10) Another example is (Psalm 72:17-19) "His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun:" What name? The next verse reveals JEHOVAH, but all of God's names are glorious!
	In some cases His name is not identified by one specific title, but by many! (Acts 3:16) "And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong." Several names are mentioned: Jesus Christ His Son Jesus, the Holy One, The Just, the Prince of Life. (Acts 3 6-13, 14-15)
	The truth is, any of God's names are worthy of asking!
	David declared in Psalms 9:10 "AND THEY THAT KNOW THY NAME WILL PUT THEIR TRUST IN THEE:"
	Two important truths to be seen from this great statement are:
	 1.They that know - know, here is our truth concerning experiential. This is a reference not to acquired knowledge but to experienced knowledge! You cannot build confidence in a product without experimenting, trying, or testing as to its ability to perform.
	2.Thy name. Illustration: Stake your name on it, credit line your conversation! Honor, integrity, what you really are (<i>Psalms</i> 44:5, 63:9)

The Kame

In Genesis 11:4 we find men seeking to make themselves a name, ⁽²¹⁾ ! A man's name defines who he truly is or should be. Nimrod sought a name for himself.

Illustrations: Cain - Abel (Jabal, Jubal, Tubalcain, Esau, Jacob, etc.)

The Word of God reminds us that because of God's deliverance of Israel from Pharaoh, *"So didst thou get thee a name."* (*Nehemiah 9:10, Isaiah 63:12-14, Jeremiah 32:20*)
